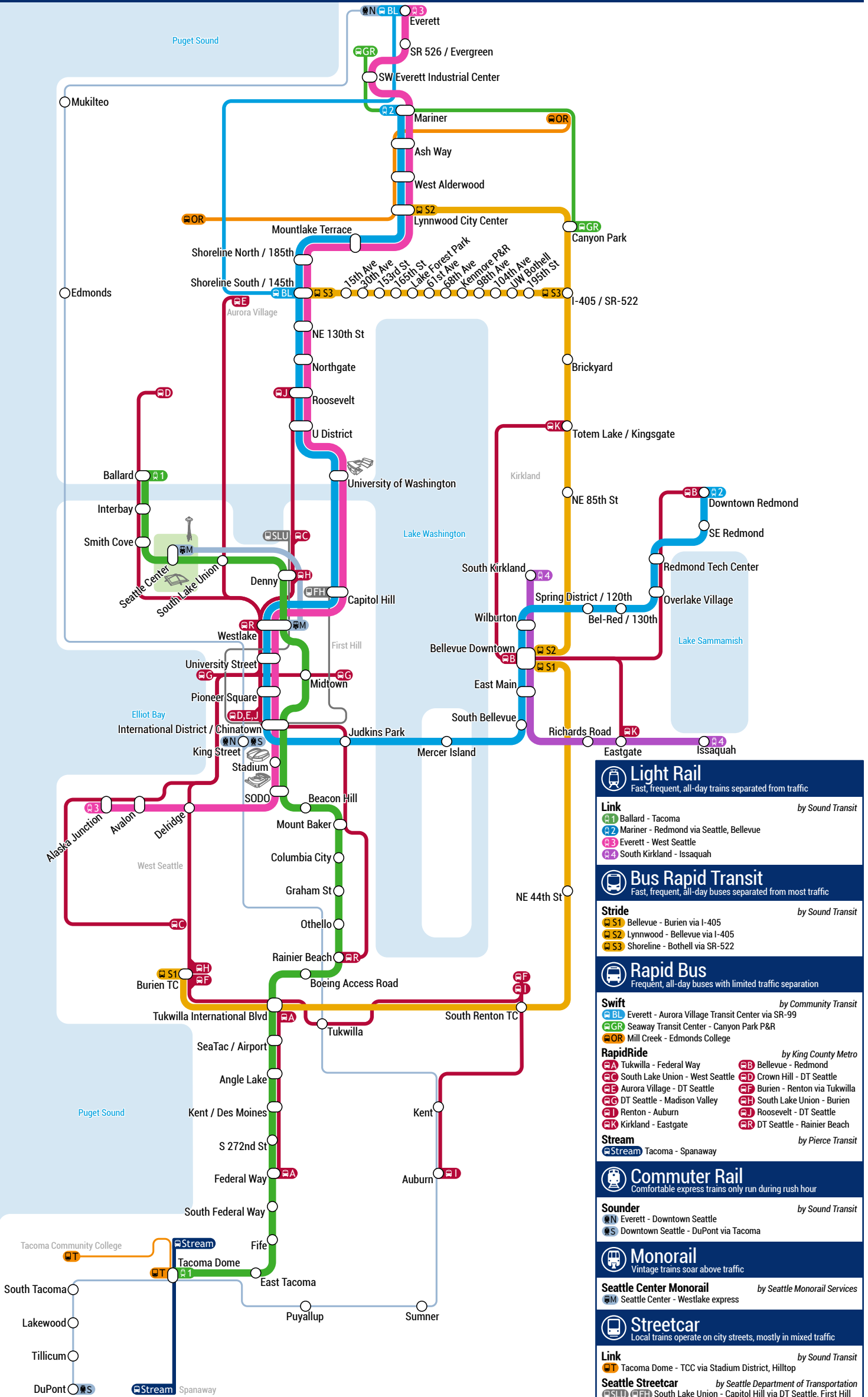




Puget Sound Rapid Transit

Light Rail
Fast, frequent, all-day trains separated from traffic

Bus Rapid Transit
Fast, frequent, all-day buses separated from most traffic

Stride *by Sound Transit*

- S1 Bellevue - Burien via I-405
- S2 Lynnwood - Bellevue via I-405
- S3 Shoreline - Bothell via SR-522

Rapid Bus
Frequent, all-day buses with limited traffic separation

- BL Everett - Aurora Village Transit Center via SR-99
- GR Seaway Transit Center - Canyon Park P&R
- OR Mill Creek - Edmonds College

Monorail
Vintage trains soar above traffic

- M Seattle Center - Westlake express

Streetcar
Local trains operate on city streets, mostly in mixed traffic
